Level 1

- This level aims to teach students the Arabic letters, the proper pronunciation, and the vowels (accents) of the Arabic language. In addition to the previous material, students will memorize several small chapters from the holy Qur'an in order to practice the learned material.
- After students complete this level, they will be able to read and pronounce the Arabic letters professionally, which will prepare them to learn how to read from the Mushaf, and hence memorize the Holy Qur'an.
- Instructors will use modern motivational teaching methods such as games and competitions to increase students' letter and word recognition ability. They will also make use of the blackboard, the overhead projector, and flashcards in order to provide students with visual aids throughout the learning process.
- Students' progress and learning are dependent on the amount of time and effort that they spend on their studies.

Level 2

- Students should memorize the *suras*: **Al Fajr, Al Gashia, Al Aala, Al Tariq, Al Buroog, Al Inshiqaq, Al Mutafifeen, Al Infitar, Al Takweer.**
- The previous rules of Tajweed taught in Al Madina book should be reviewed in this level.
